"NO KINGS" Rally and March for Immigrant Justice and Democracy

MADISON, NJ— Wind of the Spirit: Immigrant Resource Center, a New Jersey-based immigrant justice organization, invites press and community members to a peaceful rally and march in defense of immigrant communities and American democratic values.

Many of our immigrant neighbors fled authoritarian regimes in pursuit of safety, freedom, and dignity. They should not face fear and injustice in the country that promised them hope. This rally serves to:

- Oppose authoritarianism and reject the notion of unchecked executive power
- Call on the NJ Legislature to pass the Immigrant Trust Act, ensuring protection and dignity for immigrant communities
- Demand accountability and an end to ICE's indiscriminate, fear-based tactics
- Affirm the founding principle that *“In America, we don’t have kings.”*

This public action is part of the growing national “NO KINGS” movement, rejecting authoritarianism and calling for an end to ICE's unaccountable operations, while demanding that New Jersey lawmakers pass the NJ Immigrant Trust Act.

WE invite our immigrant communities, neighbors and allies to join us on Saturday, October 18th at 9:30 AM – Rally begins at Madison Train Station. Please bring powerful signs and banners with “NO KINGS” slogans, peaceful marchers boarding the train en route to Morristown and be ready to share speeches from immigrant leaders and advocates.
